General Information:

- In order to receive at the end of the year your share of money acquired by MCPP/G, you must do the following
 - ✓ **October 31st, 2009** Deadline
 - Pay dues of \$30
 - Delinquent dues will result in a penalty of \$25 per month, which will be deducted from your share of MCPP/G funds in June
 - ✓ **January 31st, 2010** Deadline
 - Enter All Event Worksheet data into the Account Manager website
 - ✓ **June 7th, 2010** Deadline
 - Submit all of your required end of event forms
- Entering data into our database means that you also agree to comply with the following MCPP/G policies
 - ✓ Attendance Agreement
 - Each school needs to attend at least two informational meetings (October, January, February or March) in order to be eligible for MCPP/G's acquired prizes and money
 - Each school agrees not to solicit from the same businesses that contribute directly to MCPP/G
 - ✓ Police Department
 - MCPP/G has had a successful working relationship with the Montgomery County Police during the After Prom/Graduation season since 1993
 - Hopefully, they will provide two (2) officers for your event (Montgomery County Schools/Montgomery County locations only) at no cost to you
 - MCPP/G requires that your membership involves the support of MCPP/G's working relationship with the MCDP, realizing that they enhance the security and safety of all attendees and volunteers

Early Prom Release *continue*:

invite undesirable consequences. Students may feel there is time to continue celebrating at private, unsupervised parties. Students on provisional licenses who drive between midnight and 5:00 a.m. are driving illegally--no exceptions. For these reasons, MCPP/G strongly recommends events end no earlier than 5:00 a.m.
